Product description

BMW lightweight Sport brake disks can be installed on the front and rear axles of M135i and M235i cars without any additional necessary measures. On the 335i and 335d, as well as the 435i and 435d, with the standard brake, the BMW lightweight Sport brake disks can be installed on the front axle without any additional necessary measures.

On cars with the 17" or 18" BMW M Sport brake (special equipment ex works), the drilled and grooved BMW lightweight Sport brake disks can be installed on the front and rear axles without any additional necessary measures.

Note: Where accessories are being retrofitted to the M Performance Sport brake, the drilled and grooved BMW lightweight Sport brake disks are already part of the retrofit kit.

Sales features / benefits

- Reduction in the build-up of a film of water between the brake pad and the brake disk thanks to countersinks and grooves.
- Low weight, therefore lower unsprung masses.
- Attractive appearance.
- Highlights sportiness, particularly in the case of alloy wheels with an open wheel design.
- The lightweight Sport brake disks are ideal for customising the car, since they **cannot be configured as a special equipment feature ex works**.



Note:

Brake disks are wear parts, and lightweight Sport brake disks can be offered as an alternative to customers having their car brake disks changed.

Homologation: No entry is required in the car's paperwork since the brake system does not change in the data relevant to the permit. ◀

Safety instructions:

The car must be run in carefully during the first 200 km after the brake disks have been installed! After the run-in time, the braking system will have reached its full effectiveness. In view of the design feature of the drilled and grooved BMW lightweight Sport brake disks, function-related noise can be generated during braking that has absolutely no impact on the stability of the brake disks.

It is recommended, when installing BMW lightweight Sport brake disks, to also install new brake pads. The BMW lightweight Sport brake disk is, just like the standard brake disk, only permitted in combination with at least 17" or 18" aluminium wheels (including in winter)!

Generally speaking, you should read the latest updates as regards wheel installation options in the EPC! ◀
